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**What we do:**

The transition services unit provides stakeholders with the necessary resources, tools, supports and professional development needed to ensure students a successful transition into further education, employment, and full participation in their community.

Transition services are a student centered planning process that is designed to meet the students educational, employment and independent living outcomes. These outcomes may include: post-secondary education; job training; employment (supported); continuing and adult education; adult services; independent living, and community participation.

Students receive an array of services to help them attain their identified post-secondary outcomes and to prepare them to be college, career and community ready. These services may include, but are not limited to; career education, career exploration, social skills and self-advocacy instruction, career technology education, in-school and community work-based learning

experiences, independent living skills instruction, and linkages to community agencies.
